

BES: Installing Security Window Film the Right Way!

A Challenging Situation

The US Department of Justice awarded a large school safety grant to the state of Wisconsin in 2018. Administered by CESA, the grant included funding for security window film and locks. It attracted hundreds of schools, but poor installation quality was a huge problem.

Schools complained about every vendor in the program, except BES. CESA asked 3M, the largest security film manufacturer, to hold a series of mandatory vendor training sessions.

BES was the only vendor exempted from this mandatory, remedial training.
